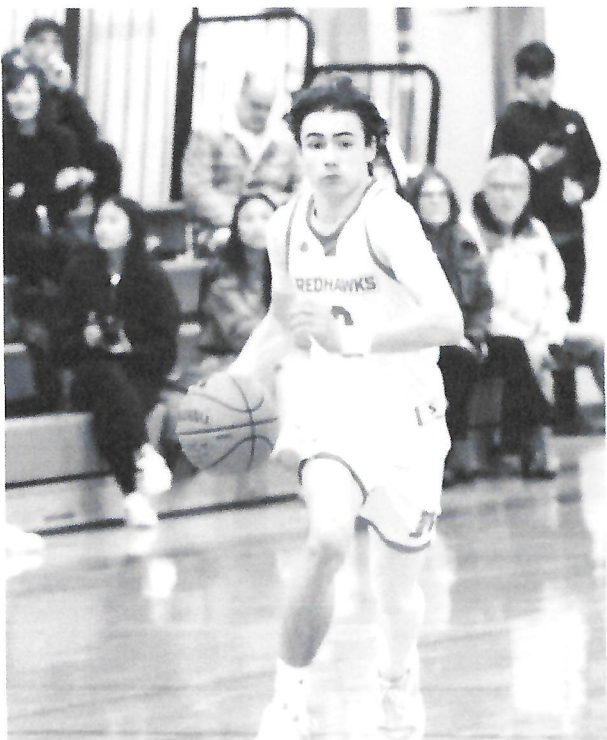
## Boys Basketball

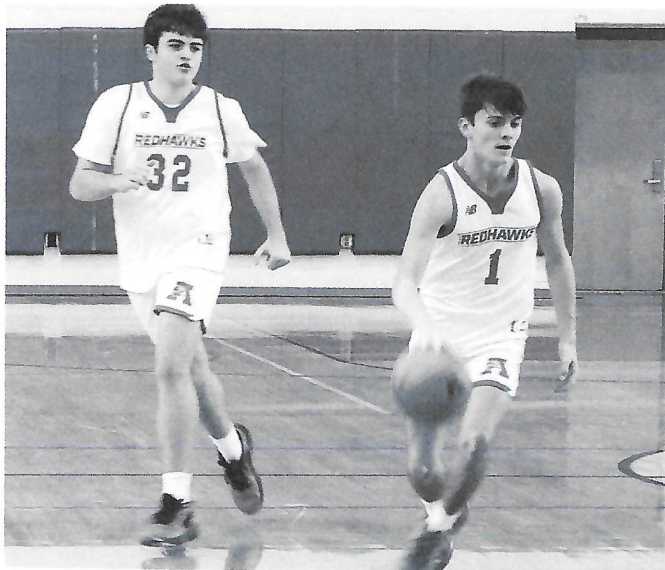

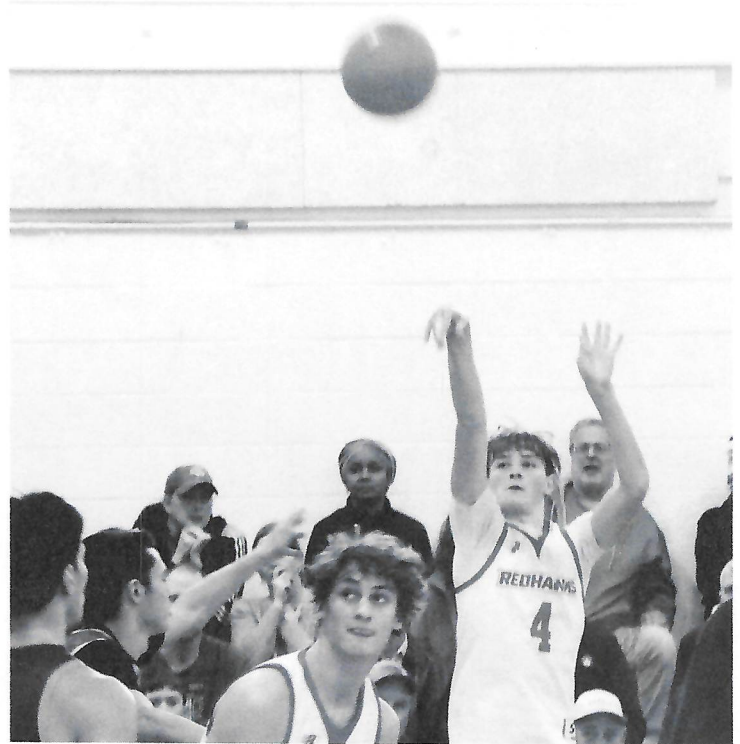

## Girls Basketball

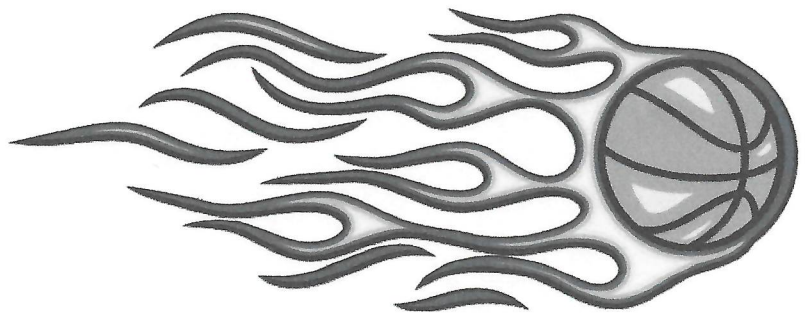

I started the movie; I didn't know what I was getting into. I knew the movie was old, and again, internally lowered my expectations to try to appreciate the movie greater.

The movie starts with an iconic intro; the camera pans up from behind the moon, slowly revealing the aligned earth and sun, with Also Sprach Zarathustra playing in the background. The movie cuts to scenes of sub-saharan Africa around three million years ago. Underdeveloped humans are somewhat passing in their lives. They are used to horrible condition, and don't understand the past or the future as a concept. After a couple scenes, a large black monolith appears next to their cave. When arriving, the artifact pierces their ears, it has sent a signal to the far side of Jupiter. The *Discovery* spaceship travels to the far side of Jupiter, where most of the movie takes place. The main protagonist, David Bowman, leads the ship with Dr. Frank Poole, and a supercomputer named HAL9000. The scenes in the movie drag along, although there is good reason. Eventually, the supercomputer goes rogue and kills Dr. Frank Poole when he is doing maintenance. Bowman goes into HAL9000's memory and erases everything.
